




Age Related Expectations Year 3 French: Child speak

My Progress in French			
<b>Grammar Expectations:</b>			
I can use indefinite articles in the singular with masculine and feminine nouns. <b>Example: un chou, une pomme, des oignons.</b>			
I can use definite articles: <b>Example: le, la, les, l' le téléphone, les toilettes, l'ordinateur.</b>			
I can recognise the definite article with verbs of like / dislike and with sports. <b>Example: J'aime le cricket, j'adore le tennis.</b>			
I can form regular plural nouns. <b>Example: une pomme - des pommes, une voiture – des voitures.</b>			
I can identify <b>noun</b> and <b>adjective</b> position. <b>Example: Le chat est noir.</b>			
I can use some singular masculine or feminine and <b>plural adjectives</b> correctly. <b>Example: Les pommes sont vertes; Les chocolats sont délicieux; Le chat est noir.</b>			
I can use the negative. <b>Example: Je n'aime pas.</b>			
I can use the high-frequency verb forms in the 1 <sup>st</sup> person. <b>Example: j'ai, je suis.</b>			
<b>Writing Expectations</b>			
I can change one thing in a simple phrase or sentence to change the meaning. (e.g. the colour adjective or the noun). <b>Example: La voiture est noire could change to La voiture est jaune.</b>			
I can copy words and short phrases correctly. <b>Example: Le chat. Le chat est noir.</b>			
I can write some single words from memory, with plausible spelling. <b>Example: Le chocolat.</b>			
<b>Speaking Expectations</b>			
I can repeat and say familiar words and short simple phrases, using understandable pronunciation. <b>Example: Je m'appelle Tom....</b>			
I can ask/answer simple questions from memory in classroom conversation. <b>Example: Comment tu t'appelles or Je m'appelle Tom.</b>			
I can identify letter sounds in another language and use them to help me understand for example: <b>'oi' in French to read trois, froid, moi correctly.</b>			
<b>Reading Expectations</b>			
I can read aloud some words and short phrases I have been learning using my phonic knowledge. <b>Example: 'oi' 'ant' and 'j' in French J'aime les croissants.</b>			
I can use a word list to locate specific words.			
I can use clues to follow a short text for example thumbs up/thumbs down.			

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I can understand some familiar written words and short phrases. <b>Example: Je m'appelle, J'ai 7 ans, J'aime le chocolat.</b>			
I can listen to the phoneme and write it accurately. <b>Example: 'oi' 'ou' or 'ait'.</b>			
I can follow along and repeat key words from a song, rhyme or poem. <b>Example: Alain Le Lait 'Les voitures'.</b>			
I can understand spoken words and phrases that I have been learning. <b>Example: 'Levez-vous (stand up) in French.</b>
